## **Abstract**

This paper describes the course of Human Rights Praxis Project on the linguistic integration of migrants in Bremerhaven, Germany, through a qualitative study approach. Drawn upon the concept of linguistic integration and importance of language from a human rights perspective, the research explores a language cafe held in the public library of Bremerhaven and observes its dynamics and characteristics through participation, and also shares some of the challenges experienced during the research. By using a semi-structured interview with the participants and facilitators, the research further discusses motivation for volunteering and effectiveness of the language cafe in terms of promoting linguistic integration.
