- Assignment Presentation -

Some hints about the presentation of your papers, essays and thesis ... (does not exempt you from following the individual instructions your lecturers might give!)

- **TITLE PAGE:** add a title page (including the <u>title of the assignment</u>, the <u>name of the module</u> and <u>name of the lecturer</u>, <u>your name</u>, <u>your matriculation number</u>, and the <u>date of submission</u>).
- PAGE NUMBERS: number the pages of your paper.
- TEXT STRUCTURE: make the structure of your text visible by using headlines and paragraphs.
- **TEXT FORMAT:** choose a standard text layout and use it consequently.
- **REFERENCING:** reference any used information, theories, quotes, etc in your assignments. There are several correct forms of citing and giving references. Our recommendation is the Harvard citation system¹. As far as laws and conventions are concerned, you can cite
 - in the text: (the official abbreviation of the law, number of article, §);
 - in the list of the bibliographical references: the abbreviation, the official name of the law, and the official website where it was published
- **SOLEMN DECLARATION:** add to every assignment/essay/thesis longer than 12 pages a solemn declaration (in Germany: eidesstattliche Erklärung) stating that the text is your own original work and all references are given.
