This work entails the report of a human rights project, tailored to a specific audience of professionals working in the trans-cultural settings of refugees and asylum seekers in Berlin, Germany which started in August 2021. It was designed as interactive workshops, to build their capacities in understanding, identifying and appropriately approaching refugees' mental health and other trauma related vulnerabilities from a human rights perspective. This report is being generated in the midst of the implementation phase of our pilot. If evaluated successful at the end of implementation, it is ready to be implied and executed to a multitude of participants in this milieu to raise their awareness to better provide protection for refugees as vulnerable groups from a perspective of mental health and human rights.
