

The Human Rights Situation of The Internally Displaced Person (IDPs) in Kalma Camp After the Withdrawal of The United Nations African Mission in Darfur (UNAMID)

The study aims to assess the human rights situation of the internally displaced person (IDPs) in Kalma camp after the withdrawal of the United Nations African Mission in Darfur (UNAMID). My main focus is on identifying the protection and security challenges faced by the IDPs, as well as violations of the economic and social rights of displaced persons, institutional responses, challenges and gaps. I will be guided by the following questions:

- 1) What are the challenges of the IDPs in Kalma camp?
- 2) What are the root causes of the Human Rights challenges within Kalma camp?
- 3) How can human rights overcome these challenges in Kalma camp?

This study will depend on a qualitative research design of a descriptive nature using questionnaires and online interviews. I will seek the support from international NGOs and local NGOs to ensure that target groups are selected based on precise criteria, but if not, I will use my personal network of individuals from the specific IDP camp.
