**The right to employment:
Develop a platform for the Transgender (Hijra) to strengthening the community**

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“You have the right not to be fired or refused a job or promotion because you are transgender. This is true even if your state and locality have not passed laws explicitly prohibiting gender identity discrimination. You have the right to be treated with respect and not be harassed” With this highlighted keynote in the following pages I would like to share a workshop which has been done under the Human Rights Project which is designed by me to serve the purpose of my Master’s program. This HR project was built based on my M.A thesis research on Discrimination against Transgender (Hijra) people at employment in Bangladesh. The project comprises a CV writing workshop which is formulated by the demand of the Transgender (hijra) community through the survey. Using my research topic as a starting point the goal of the workshops is to boost the personal skill and human rights consciousness of the transgender community. Participatory methods such as verbal and written will be used to heighten self-learning/awareness and expand learning/awareness toward others. Impressions and feedback from the workshops may inform upcoming fieldwork in the center of Bangladesh.
