Who is the ASH Pre-Study Program for?

The ASH Pre-Study Program is aimed at all newcomers, i.e. international and refugee prospective students who have not obtained their educational qualifications in Germany and cannot yet apply for a regular course of study at ASH Berlin.

What can you expect from the ASH Pre-Study Program?

Das The ASH Pre-Study Program lasts 1 year (August to July) and consists of:

- Completion of the preparatory German course (level B1 to C1)
- Attendance of first seminars (creditable for regular studies)
- Completion of further study-specific admission requirements (including completion of a pre-study internship)
- Completion of the internal German language test for university admission (DSH)
- Support and guidance during the program and with the final application for regular studies by peer mentors and a social worker

How are you accepted into the ASH Pre-Study Program?

Application phase April 15 to May 15 (annually)

Prerequisite for participation:

- Successful completion of the placement test (language level German B1)
- University entrance qualification

Documents to be submitted:

- Letter of motivation (English or German, maximum two pages)
- Curriculum vitae (English or German)
- Identity document (copy)
- University entrance qualification (copy); if you do not have these documents, please contact us by e-mail or telephone
