

ASH Pre-Study Program for Refugees



For whom is the ASH Pre-Study Program?

The ASH Pre-Study Program prepares refugees that are not yet able to apply for a regular study program at ASH with the competences and necessary prerequisites for studies to finally enrol as a regular student.

What to expect from the ASH Pre-Study Program?

The ASH Pre-Study Program has a duration of 2 semesters (Oct. to July):

- German and orientation courses - level B2 until C1 (however, we plan to establish an A1-course by mid-August)
- Attendance of specific courses and seminars (credible for regular study programs)
- Completion of specific courses and seminars
- Completion of study-specific admission requirements (such as inter alia: the completion of a pre-study placement, a first aid course) **How to apply for the ASH Pre-Study Program?** *Application process: 1st to 31st of July (every year)*

Required documents are:

- Letter of Motivation (German or English, max. 2 pages)
- Curriculum Vitae/ Résumé (German or English)
- Residence Permit (copy)
- if available, proof or information about German language skills
- University entrance qualification (copy) or a note saying that the University entrance qualification document will be handed in until the end of the ASH Pre-Study Program)

The documents can be sent as of now by E-mail to pre-studies@ash-berlin.eu.

The course (A1) takes place on three weekdays at the ASH Berlin. It is free of charge, only travel costs are carried by participants themselves.
